



**Attention Stakeholders:**

In 2021, Life Beyond Barriers Rehabilitation Group (LBBRG) provided therapy services to 1 newborn/infant, 9 toddlers, 15 children, 12 adolescents, and 277 adults. 46% of clients achieved all goals or their plan of care was successfully met. LBBRG has future plans to track outcome measures, therefore data is inconclusive related to specific outcomes. There were no unplanned transfers to acute facilities. Clients were discharged to their home/community environment. LBBRG works with clients and families to address, identify, and define intended discharge environments to promote an enhanced level of function, greatest level of independence, quality of life, and safety, with return to school, work, community (as defined by the client), and home environment.

Below, is the number of patients/cases with medical diagnoses served in 2021, with average visits per case.

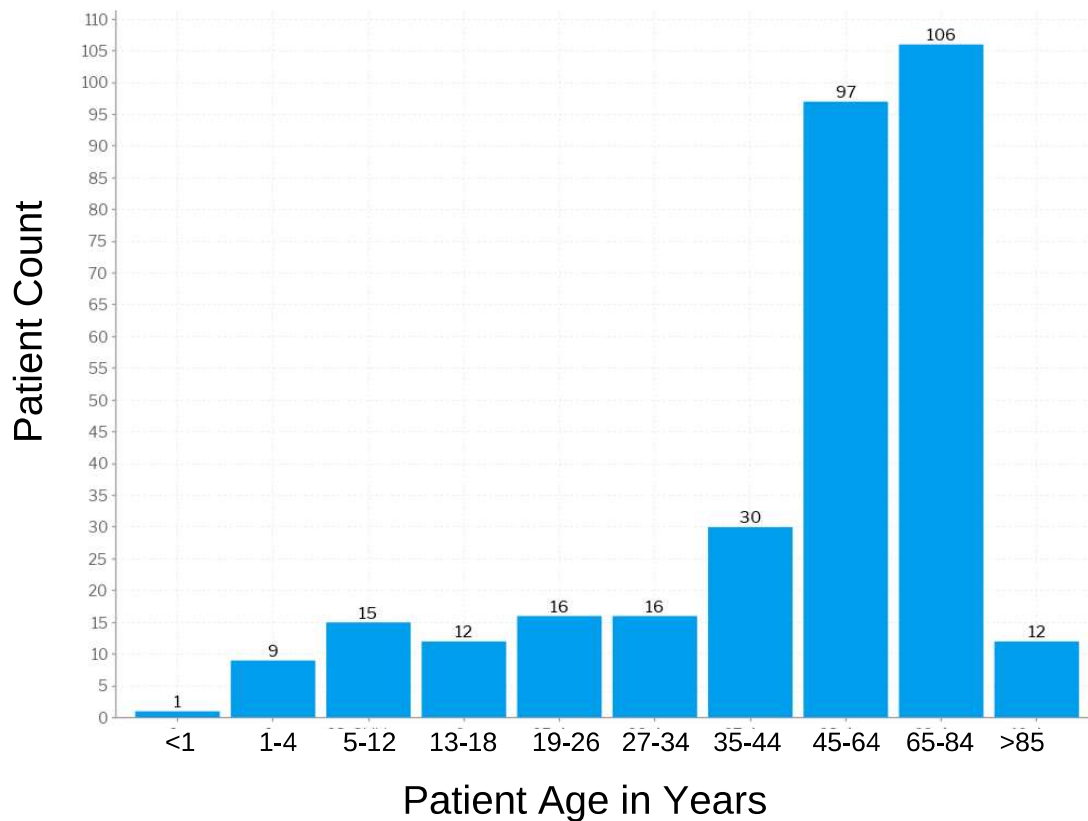

## Attention Stakeholders (continued)

Life Beyond Barriers Rehabilitation Group (LBBRG) is an all-inclusive environment with universal acceptance, serving qualifying individuals (defined as able to tolerate therapy and medically stable) of all ages, races, ethnicities, socioeconomic status, abilities, gender/sexual orientation(s), religion.

In 2021, the persons served were of all ages:



LBBRG requires a physician prescription for services, but accepts referrals from primary care physicians, specialty physicians, case managers, inpatient rehabilitation/hospital, outpatient therapy, home care, extended care facilities, senior/assisted living, vendors, community resources, attorneys, and insurers. Delivery mode of services is by referral only.

For 2021, NPS score was 89.3 and therapy value was rated 4.9/5.0 by clients.
